2 Minutes of 17th January were agreed.

3 Matters arising. None.

4 Following the meeting with Emma Betteridge at the BDBC Offices the day before, (Ed Rehill was indisposed), it was agreed to implement as many of the recommendations in the document sent out by ER and discussed and clarified by EB. A further meeting would be sought with ER to work through the wording of the policies to ensure they complied with planning language.

5 It was agreed to withdraw Policy RE1 (Renewable Energy) as it would not be possible to comply with all the requirements. JD will write to tell ER. The Policy on Flooding would be reviewed and a decision taken as to whether it was necessary or if all the requirements were included in the LP Policy EM7. Assistance would be sought from EB for the maps in the approved formats. BJ will send the Traffic and Road Safety report to HCC for their comments.

6 Regulation 14 leaflet. There were further amendments made to the leaflet.

7 VR had assisted with getting 3 quotes required for the PC. The LVL had declined to deliver the document as it was too bulky. A team of volunteers would be used to do this.

8 The Clerk had confirmed that the PC website had sufficient capacity for the NDP pre-submission consultation documents. She still had not replied to the request for electronic comments. Hard copies would be placed in the House 28, 2 hairdressers, Chineham and Basingstoke Libraries (tbc).

9 IW offered to look at the materials needed for the publicising of the Regulation 14 process and Open Sessions.

10 An article for the LVL was not discussed.

11 PD gave out the lists of Statutory Consultees from BDBC and Bramley for consideration and suggestions for SoL.

12 IW had some suggestions for the Traffic Report.

13 The date of the next meeting would be dependent on the next meeting with Ed Rehill.
